EVENT STRUCTURE

Round 1: Theme-Based Photography

A theme will be announced on the spot. Participants must capture photographs based on the given theme.

Time limit: 45–60 minutes

Location: Campus premises only

Number of photos: 1–3 photos

Photos must be taken within the event duration only. Use of previously captured images is strictly prohibited. Minimal/basic edits only (brightness, contrast, cropping)

Evaluation Criteria (Round 1)

Creativity – 40 marks

Relevance to Theme – 40 marks

Basic Composition – 20 marks

Total – 100 marks

Round 2: Photo Series(Final Round)

Shortlisted participants will submit a series of 3–5 photographs based on a theme. participants include a short caption or concept (2–3 lines) to their photo set.

Evaluation Criteria (Round 2)

Creativity – 30 marks

Composition – 25 marks

Relevance to Theme – 20 marks

Technical Quality – 15 marks

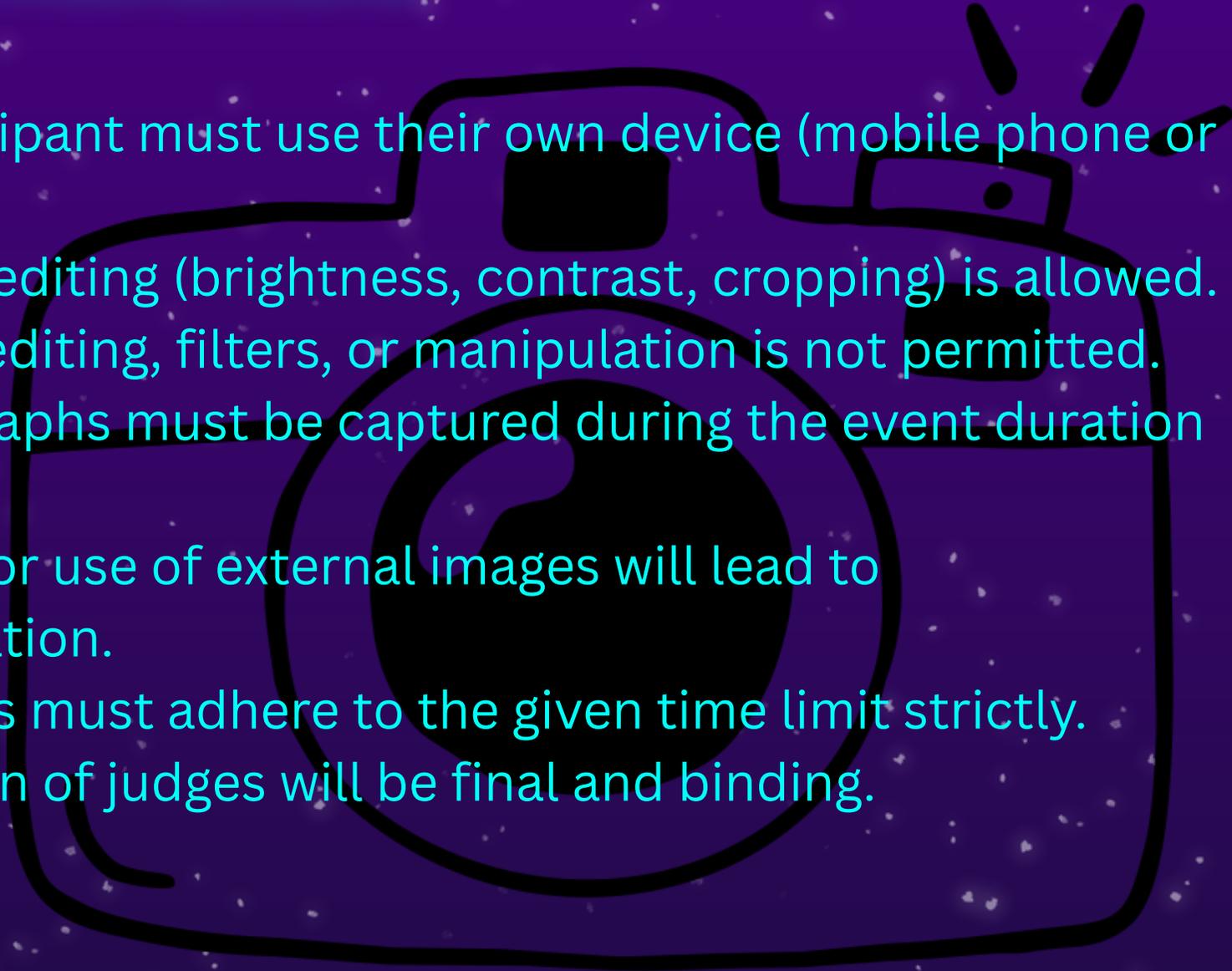
Caption / Concept – 10 marks

Total – 100 marks



Rules & Instructions

- Each participant must use their own device (mobile phone or camera).
- Only basic editing (brightness, contrast, cropping) is allowed.
- Advanced editing, filters, or manipulation is not permitted.
- All photographs must be captured during the event duration only.
- Plagiarism or use of external images will lead to disqualification.
- Participants must adhere to the given time limit strictly.
- The decision of judges will be final and binding.



Submission Guidelines

- Format: JPG / PNG
- Number of photos: As per round requirement
- Submission mode: Google Form / Email / WhatsApp (as decided by organizers)

Late submissions will not be accepted.

Note:

Participants are expected to maintain discipline during the event. Any violation of rules will result in disqualification.
